A few notes for your consideration.

#### **Free School Meal Holiday vouchers**

We shall be distributing vouchers for eligible children for the summer holiday on Wednesday 17 July. Funding has been set at  $1 \times 100$  for the duration of the summer holiday per eligible child.

### **Sports Day**

The weather looks good for the day and therefore sports day will be taking place on Wednesday 17 July. As per previous communications, we would like to extend an invitation to parents of the current Year 7, 8, 9 and 10 students to watch the activities on the 17 July.

Viewing is restricted to an area of the field at the top end of the site and no seating is available. I am afraid there is no parking available on the school site; please be considerate towards our residential neighbours if you are parking nearby.

For Year 9 and 10 the event starts at 10.10am to 12.15pm, please do not come on to the site before 10.00am. For Year 7 and 8 the event starts at 1.10pm, please do not come on to the site before 1.00pm. At the end of the Year 7 and 8 event, parents may, if desired, take their children home with them. On the day, students are permitted to wear their Knole Academy PE Kit or house t-shirts for the day.

### Climbing
